Espoo Convention's Points of Contact in Estonia, Sweden, Germany (State of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania), Norway and Austria

### **Supplementary information in accordance with the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) for the project plan to construct a new nuclear power plant in Finland**

As Party of Origin, Finland is hereby sending supplementary information to the EIA report on Fennovoima Oy's project plan to construct a new nuclear power plant in Finland to all countries involved in the procedure.

In the statement by the contact authority for the EIA report on Fennovoima Oy's Nuclear Power Project (7131/815/2008, 7.5.2008), the Ministry of Employment and the Economy determined that certain issues need more precise examination in a supplementary report. The supplementary report is needed for the processing of a potential application for a Government resolution (decision-in-principle).

Enclosed is a report of the answers to the questions by Estonia, Germany and Sweden with a summary of further clarifications on topics of national interest, a separate answer to Austrian Government regarding worst case severe accident scenario as well as the statement by the contact authority for the EIA report.

The EIA procedure for Fennovoima Oy's Nuclear Power Project has now ended. Possible comments on the supplementary report will be included in the processing for an application for a decision-in-principle and should therefore be sent to the Ministry of Employment and the Economy (P.O. Box 32, FI-00023 GOVERNMENT, Finland).

As Party of Origin, Finland will also subsequently inform all countries involved in the procedure about the decisions in question as requested in Espoo Convention, Article 6 and in accordance with Council Directive 85/337/EEC, Article 7.
